



## Missouri HOSA 2026 Outstanding Local Leader Award

The Missouri HOSA Outstanding Local Leader Award is designed to recognize an outstanding Missouri HOSA member who has demonstrated involvement in HOSA achievement, leadership ability, community service, and citizenship.

### Eligibility:

All active HOSA chapters are eligible to nominate one (1) local leader for the Outstanding Local Leader Award. Current Missouri HOSA State Officers are not eligible for this award.

### Award Criteria:

- Active membership and involvement in their HOSA chapter
- Strong commitment to promoting HOSA's vision, mission, and goals throughout their school and community.
- A focus on community engagement and support
- Model of positive behavior and supports fellow chapter members.

### Guidelines:

- Members of each Local Chapter along with their Local Chapter Advisor will be responsible for completing the application and providing all requested documentation.
- One Outstanding Local Leader will be selected each year.
- All event submissions must include the following:
  1. The Outstanding Local Leader Application
  2. A description of nominee's community service activities – limited to one-page, 12 pt. font
  3. A one-page essay written by the nominee describing why they should be selected as the Outstanding Local Leader – limited to one-page, 12 pt. font
  4. Digital color headshot of nominee in business attire or HOSA Official Attire.
  5. A copy of nominee's current resume – limited to one-page
- Event submissions for Outstanding Local Leader are **due by midnight, February 15, 2026**. All event submissions should be submitted directly to the Missouri HOSA State Advisor by [this link](#).

### Award Selection, Notification & Recognition:

- Award recipients will be selected by an Awards Committee (AC).
- The judging panel will select one local leader to receive this award.
- Nominators will be notified of nominees' award status in early March.
- Award recipients will be recognized at the annual Missouri HOSA State Leadership Conference.
