FLC RECAP

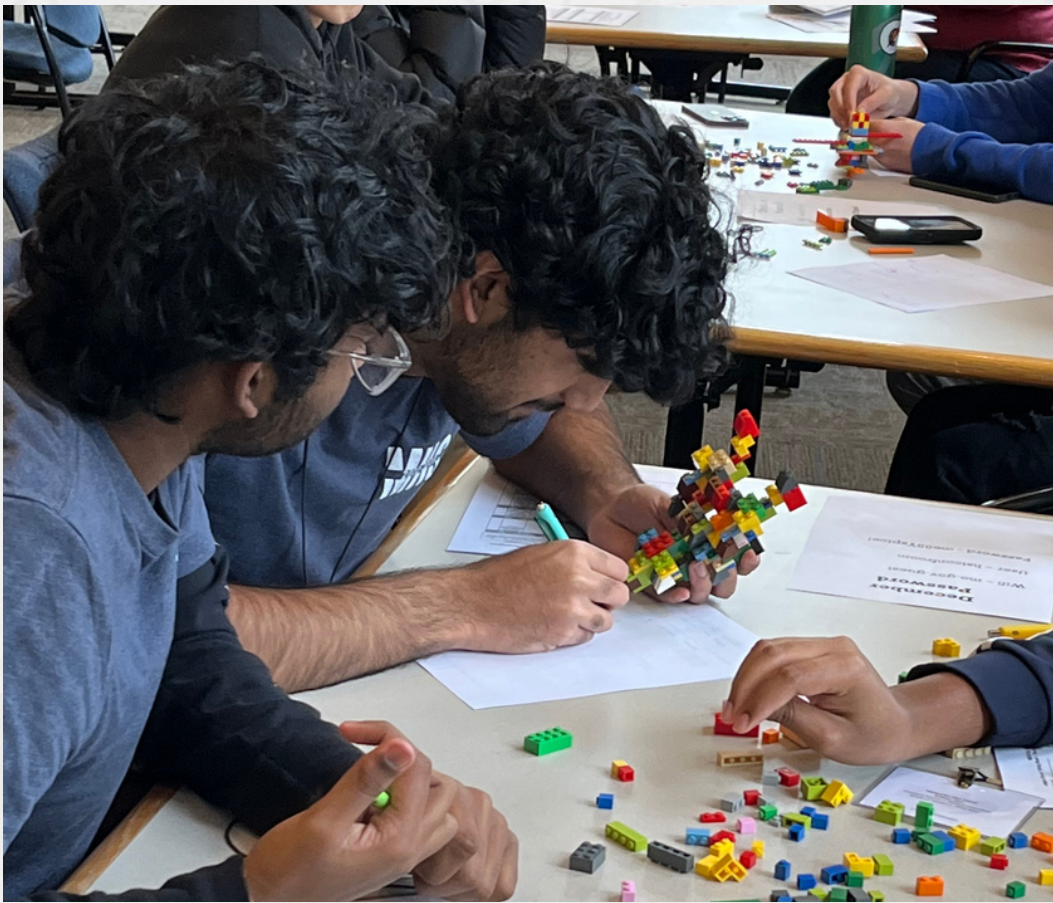
